Marathon & Relay - 1996 - Results

The 14th running of the Beaverlodge to Grande Prairie Marathon is now history. Although the weather was not the best (very windy - fortunately from the back, cool and rainy), a total of 73 runners took part. This is the largest turnout in a number of years. The marathon number remained stable with 16 registrants and 13 finishers. The 2 person relay teams were up and there was a good number of 3 & 4 person teams.

Bill Corcoran was to have teamed with Patrick Mackenzie in an attempt to break the course record but misfortune prevented Patrick from attending so Bill ran the whole distance and finished first in 2:57:1. He indicated before the race that he was going to "show how to run a three hour marathon on a limited amount of training for one."

Three runners, Rick Prediger, Doug Arcus, and David Rust ran their first marathons while Jim Smith completed his 13th on this course (he missed only 1985). It was great to see three runners journey from Victoria for the event.

Janet Littleton-Riendeau also ran her first. Although she had not run further than 8 1/2 miles in the past, she decided to go all the way and finished in 4:25. This shows what can be accomplished if you put your mind to it and ignore the advice of others who said it shouldn't be done.
